NTC Interim Child Protection Policies for Juniors participating in:

- **Senior Ladders**
- **Senior DLTC Teams/Senior External Competitions**
- **Tuesday Night Social Tennis/Internal Competitions**

Senior Ladders

- One parent/guardian must be present for the duration of the match.
- In the event that the junior is injured during play, seniors should not leave the court alone with the junior to apply first aid. Ensure that another senior is present if this event occurs.

DLTC Matches/Senior External Competitions

- Parental/guardian attendance may or may not be required.
- Team members and Captains should ensure that a junior is not left alone in the car when travelling to and from away games with any one senior.
- Two cars generally leave the Club to travel to away matches. If the driver is travelling with 2 juniors they should not drop one off first and be left alone with the other.
- Lifts should be arranged and planned in advance to avoid this. Similarly, the driver should not drop seniors off en route home and be left with a junior alone in the car. If there is a reasonable chance that this may occur, the team and Captain should arrange that the parent/guardian transport the junior to and from the match.
- For home and away matches, the team and Captain should ensure that the junior has phoned their parent/guardian when the match has finished indicating an accurate time for the junior to be collected.
- In the event that the parent/guardian has not arrived at the arranged time, more than one senior must wait with the junior until the parent/guardian arrives.
- In the event that the junior is injured during play, seniors should not leave the court alone with the junior to apply first aid. Ensure that another senior is present if this event occurs.

Tuesday Night Social Tennis/ Internal Competitions

- Parental/guardian attendance at these events is not compulsory.
- Tuesday Night Social Tennis: Nominated Juniors must be collected at 9.30pm from the Clubhouse. In the event that there is a reasonable chance that the tournament may finish prior to this, the Organiser must ensure that the junior has phoned their parent/guardian prior to their final game to indicate a time that they will be finished. Parents/guardians must ensure that they are on time to collect their child.
- Internal Competitions: Junior players must ring their parent/guardian prior to their final game to indicate a time that they will be finished. The Organiser must ensure that this has been undertaken. Parents/guardians must ensure that they are on time to collect their child.
- In the event that the junior is injured during play, seniors should not leave the court alone with the junior to apply first aid. Ensure that another senior is present if this event occurs.
